Dear Elders and Sisters,

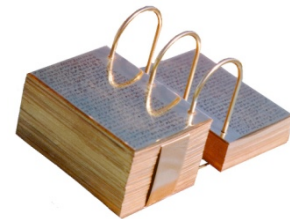
