It's an amazing time to be in the mission field when we've begun the roll-out of the long awaited "Simplified Curriculum". I think all of you have found "The District 2" to be uplifting and very real. We first trained all the leaders and all the Sisters in a four day Leadership Training Meeting. Missionary Miracles




From Sisters Hallewell & Crawford,
