Dear Elders and Sisters,

This year, the flu seems to be starting up a little early, so PLEASE review this information on prevention, symptoms, and treatment.

PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF FLU

Most respiratory infections are spread by inhaling droplets in the air or by touching the hand to the mouth, nose, or eyes or through the air by droplets resulting from coughing or sneezing.



• Check your temperature: People with temperature >100.5°F (38° C) should stay at home. Do not go out until the fever resolves.

Look for some (hand sanitizer)

Those with strong immunity, can often fight off the flu even after they have been exposed



Don't forget good sleep!!! (and use the power of prayers!).

SYMPTOMS

The symptoms occur in one to four days after exposure. They include: cough, sneezing, fever, chills, sore throat, headache and body aches, fatigue, and occasionally vomiting and diarrhea. Worsening cough and onset of difficulty breathing suggest onset of pneumonia and should prompt immediate medical attention.

TREATMENT IS SYMPTOMATIC

- Nasal congestion: decongestants, elevating head, using humidifier.
- Fever: acetaminophen, aspirin, ibuprofen.
- Call your medical resources for help for high fever; severe throat, face, or ear pain; or prolonged and worsening symptoms.
