PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

To those who embrace the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Lord has promised "peace in this life and eternal life in the world to come." Those with whom we meet, and those whom we teach greatly need the blessings of the gospel in their lives, just as we do. The Lord, knowing the calamities and trials of the last days, has provided a way for His children to have peace and joy. You are the messengers of that extraordinary blessing!

This past month I have shared with many of you thoughts about the necessity of making wise decisions. I suggest that in these "perilous times" those decisions can only be made by the power of the Holy Ghost. And yet the majority of Heavenly Father's children do not yet have that necessary gift, nor do they know where to find it. As a result, they exist as Joel prophesied they would in the latter day. "Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the Lord is near in the valley of decision." (Joel 3:14)

Even so, men and women seem unable to find the source of peace, or to understand what will bring them true happiness. As Joel described, most people live from day to day, unable to understand the purpose of existence or the way to find joy. There is a terrible modern emptiness which most try to fill with heady pleasure, thrills, and material possession. Unable to find joy in these unwise decisions, they wander unhappily in the valley of decision.

Paul described this same condition in his letter to Timothy, describing men in the last days as "lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God...Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth." (2 Timothy 3:2-7)

Small wonder that there is so much unhappiness among Heavenly Father's children. The solution to this modern dilemma can be found only through the Atonement of Jesus Christ. Only through Christ and His loving guidance can we find peace and joy. By taking upon ourselves His covenants and promises — by receiving His ordinances, we can bind ourselves to Heavenly Father and His purposes, and thus escape the despair of our time. We come to look upon life with purpose, and upon our brothers and sisters with charity. Emptiness is filled with the love of God, and worldly riches are replaced by the treasures of eternity.

As we share this critical solution with our brothers and sisters, we must – on behalf of the Lord – challenge them to use the power of the Holy Ghost, granted to them for a time by their loving Father, to make the decision to leave the valley of decision and find peace through the covenants and ordinances of baptism. By so doing, they will become eligible to receive the Gift of the Holy Ghost and the guidance to make the wise decisions that bring joy and eternal life. We must do this boldly, as

directed by the Spirit. As we testify of the blessings of the gospel in our own lives and in the lives of those we love, the Spirit will whisper peace to them and will encourage them to make these important decisions. How great shall be their joy!
